

# Classroom Project Grants Guidelines

## Kiwanis Club of Green Valley

**Purpose of the Grants:** *to provide funds for classroom teachers who have an innovative idea for a project that utilizes the CCSD curriculum from an imaginative approach. One grant will be awarded to a teacher at each of seven high schools with Key Clubs supported by the Kiwanis Club of Green Valley and to a teacher at Cannon Junior High.*

**Eligibility:** *Certified CCSD teacher at one of the following schools: Coronado, Del Sol, Green Valley, Liberty, Silverado, Coral Academy, Basic or Cannon Junior High School.*

**Grant Amounts:** *Up to \$500 per grant, one grant to each of the eight schools previously mentioned. The program is designed to be the sole funding agent for your project. A budget must be included with your application. Grant monies will be written in the form of a check to the school.*

### Other Guidelines:

- The project should be of your creation—this program will not fund the purchase of a pre-packaged lesson.
- Your **Project Objective(s)** should describe the expected student learning outcomes.
- Your **Project Description** should describe sequentially what the students will do. Provide enough information so that judges will have a clear understanding of the project.
- The deadline for the application is **Friday, December 9, 2022**. You may submit the application by mail or email. Winning teachers will be notified if their project has been funded on or before **Friday, December 16, 2022**.
- School principal or VP/Curriculum signature is required on all applications.
- Projects with hands-on activities that benefit large number of students will have a better chance of being chosen.
- At the completion of the classroom projects, teachers will be asked to submit a short summary and present any materials that support the success of the project.
