



Green Valley Kiwanis Club Classroom Project Grants Guidelines

Purpose of the Grants: *to provide funds for classroom teachers who have an innovative idea for a project that utilizes the CCSD curriculum from an imaginative approach. One grant will be awarded to a teacher at each of eight high schools with Key Clubs supported by the Green Valley Kiwanis club and to a teacher at Cannon Junior High.*

Eligibility: *Certified CCSD teacher at one of the following schools: Coronado, Del Sol, Green Valley, Liberty, Silverado, Coral Academy, Foothill, Basic or Cannon Junior High School.*

Grant Amounts: *Up to \$500 per grant, one grant to each of the nine schools previously mentioned. The program is designed to be the sole funding agent for your project. A budget must be included with your application. Grant monies will be written in the form of a check to the school.*

Other Guidelines:

- The project should be of your creation—this program will not fund the purchase of a pre-packaged lesson.
- Your **Project Objective(s)** should describe the expected student learning outcomes.
- Your **Project Description** should describe sequentially what the students will do. Provide enough information so that judges will have a clear understanding of the project.
- Additional applications may be copied if needed.
- The deadline for the application is **Wednesday, October 30, 2019**. You may submit the application by mail, email or fax. Teachers will be notified whether or not your project has been funded by **Friday, November, 15, 2019**.
- Your principal's signature will be required on the application.
- We believe that projects with hands-on activities for students will be the most beneficial for students and therefore have a better chance of being chosen.
- You may submit applications for more than one project. Please submit a separate application per project.
- The final due date to complete the project and submit the summary for this award will be determined after the final nine projects are selected.
- At the completion of the classroom projects, teachers will be asked to submit a short summary and present any materials that support the success of the project.
