SLP Service Project Grants Proposal

Purpose of the Grants: *To provide funds for Green Valley Sponsored Leadership Programs to create impactful service initiatives that SLP members find important to their communities. One grant per Kiwanis Financial year will be awarded to each Green Valley Sponsored Leadership Program that submits an application that is approved by the Board of Green Valley Kiwanis.*

Eligibility: **Builders Club** of Cannon Middle School; **Key Clubs** of Basic, Coronado, Coral Academy, Del Sol, Foothill, Green Valley, Liberty and Silverado High Schools; **Circle K** Club of UNLV.

Grant Amounts: *Up to \$200 per grant, one grant to each of the SLPs previously mentioned. A project budget must be included with your application. Project monies will be written as a check to the appropriate school account for the specific SLP.*

Other Guidelines:

- ✓ The Kiwanis Club of Green Valley will support their SLP Clubs by awarding grants for service projects they wish to complete. We always encourage our SLP Club Members to ask for advice, support and help from Kiwanis throughout the year, about projects, academics, scholarships and leadership.
- ✓ The service project should be of the SLP Club's creation—this program will not fund attendance at a project run by a different organization, but you may work with other organizations.
- ✓ Your *Project Objective(s)* should describe the expected outcomes for the community, the people and places impacted and how.
- ✓ Your *Project Description* should describe sequentially what the SLP members will do, and what community members may be involved as well as what those contacts will do. Provide enough information so that there is a clear understanding of the project.
- ✓ Applications can be found online at www.greenvalleykiwanis.net.
- ✓ It is preferred that applications be submitted one month in advance of intended project date. You may submit the application by email, mail, or hand delivery. Submitted applications will be discussed and reviewed at each Green Valley Kiwanis Board meeting held on the second Tuesday of the month.
- ✓ SLP Officer or Project Chair and Faculty or Kiwanis Advisor signature are required.
- ✓ We believe that projects that include hands-on activities for SLP members will be the most beneficial for SLP members experience and therefore have a better chance of being approved.
- ✓ We recommend you utilize this money to plan a service project that keeps your membership active and engaged, especially during times such as spring or summer when there are fewer events.
- ✓ You may submit applications for more than one project, but only one project per SLP Club will be funded as a part of this program per financial year. It is preferred that the SLP Club submit the project they believe in most. Please submit a separate application per project. You may re-submit improved applications after receiving feedback.
- ✓ This is not a competition; SLP clubs' project applications have no impact on each other.
- ✓ At the completion of the project, the SLP club will be expected to submit a summary of their project with pictures and visit a Green Valley Kiwanis meeting to present their summary.
